Ways to Give

1. Loose Cash / Cheques in Collection Plate

We cannot collect Gift Aid on anonymous donations. Cheques should be made payable to "St Martin's PCC".

2. Numbered Envelopes

If you wish to use this method, please write your name in the form below, tick the appropriate box and give it to the Treasurer (Ruth Gaskins) If you pay tax, please also fill in the Gift Aid declaration on the next page- this makes every £1 you donate worth £1.25 to the church. We must have all the details below, with your signature – it is not enough to say "I want this to be gift-aided".

3. Direct into Church Bank Account

If you wish to set up a Standing Order, or make donations using on-line banking, please use the following details:

Your bank should not need a special form for a Standing Orders, nor do you need to tell the church in advance how much you are paying, or how often. But, if you pay tax and have not already done so, please fill in the Gift Aid declaration on the next page – the name on the account must be the same as that on the declaration.

If you don't pay tax, or have already given us a Gift Aid form which is still valid you do not need to fill in a declaration.

Gift Aid Declaration

We will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give.

- No longer pay sufficient tax on your income and / or capital gains.

If you pay income tax at a higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self- Assessment Tax return to receive the additional tax relief due to you.

Please treat as Gift Aid donations all qualifying gifts of money to St Martin's PCC, made up until the date of this declaration and in the past four years. ☐

Please treat all gifts of money that I make to St Martin's PCC, from the date of this declaration onwards, as Gift Aid donations. ☐
